SPLITVIEW Activation/Deactivation

Due to various state laws, SPLITVIEW is currently only allowed in certain states. As of August 1, 2014, the state of Wisconsin now allows SPLITVIEW.

All vehicles equipped with SPLITVIEW will arrive with this feature de-activated from the factory. Activation can only occur as outlined in LI82.85-P-048667.

This bulletin has been created and maintained in accordance with MBUSA-SLP S423QH001, Document and Data Control, and MBUSA-SLP S424HH001, Control of Records.

SPLITVIEW Activation is only allowed in the following states, including the District of Columbia:
