ACTION / SUMMARY INFORMATION

Action: Open this Preliminary Evaluation.

Summary:

ODI has received 21 reports from consumers alleging rear lighting failures in the brake and/or turn signals of the subject vehicles. The failure can cause the lights to dim, or cause the lights to not illuminate at all. The failure typically occurs in either the left or right tail lamp assembly however some consumers have reported simultaneous failures. The reports typically indicate the failure is with the lamp connector, with many indicating a burnt and/or melted condition of the electrical components. In multiple instances consumers have reported smelling smoke and seeing burn marks in the trunks of the vehicles. One consumer reported seeing small flames emanating from the rear lamp connector when the trunk was opened.

NHTSA is opening this investigation to evaluate the scope, frequency, and consequence of the alleged defect.
