
Mercedes Fix-in-Place Sunroof Clips



Step 1 – Move the sunroof back approx. 1/3 of the way.



Step 2 – Remove the 2 Torx screws from the carriage located up under the glass. Repeat for the other side. Now slide the glass back about 6" to gain access to the clips.



Step 3 – Remove the old/broken clips. If they are not broken, they may be cut out with a utility knife or oscillating tool.

Slide the new clips onto each rail. Assure the gap is facing upwards. Drop the carriage pins into the saddle of the new clips.




Old clips removed

Step 4 – Add a drop of super glue into the saddle of the new clips. Also add a drop of glue to the small retaining insert.

Use a pair of needle nose pliers to slide the retaining insert down into the clip. Press firmly to seat the insert well and provide good contact for the glue.



IMPORTANT Step 5 – Leave undisturbed for 24 hours. Do not move the carriage along the rails.

Allow the glue to cure for 24 hours before screwing the glass back onto the carriage.
