😊 **Folding Mirror Magic**

One quick way of giving your 202 an *updated* exterior is by replacing the dumbbo sized side mirrors with sleeker model updated W210 mirrors with the integrated LED indicators. But why stop there? Go one step further by installing the european market only folding W210 mirrors.

While the W210 mirrors are enough to make other 202 owners do a double take, watching them see as your mirrors electronically fold into the side body is another. The parts are easily found at your local dealer or from our resident euro parts man Steve.



Here is a break down of some of the parts you will need for this installation:

W210 Model update side mirrors (note these numbers are for the non power folding)

Installation is pretty straight forward. Wires that you will need to run to your doors are for both the folding/unfolding and the blinker wires. Start by removing the original mirrors, door cards and various interior trim to make installation easier. Once removed you can then run the green and yellow wires from the power folding harness from the center console to each doors.



While running the wires its a good time to run the blinking wires up the doors to save time. On the MY 1995 we used for installation we've tapped the Black/White and Black/Green wires for the blinking portion. If you are unsure as to which wires colour your car uses for the blinking to the rear lights use a multimeter to figure out which wires you will need to use.



The long blue wire on the folding mirror switch needs to be run to the fuse box located on the drivers side of the engine compartment. By undoing the screws that hold down the unit pop out the section that contains the #24 fuse. Flip this portion over to install the spaded end of the blue wire to the 24A slot.



On the wire harness there is a brown wire that needs to be grounded. We've decided to ground it on the passenger side foot well as there was already a grounding point there. Any good ground will work for this.

Next find the blue/purple illumination wire and tap that off an existing blue/purple wire to provide illumination for the switch. We've used the one that was attached to the remote trunk switch.

Once you have all the wires secured attach wire harness of the W210 mirrors to the connectors on the car (If you have the standard square connector that comes with the W210 mirrors you can either covert your existing connector on the car to the W210 style or swap wire harness from your old mirrors to your new ones. Either way it will work) and slide on the cover.

Test to make sure you have correctly tapped the blinking wires to make sure the indicators on the mirrors blink. To test the power folding portion turn your car on and depress the switch. If you've done your wires right you will see your mirrors move!



Finish up the installtion by putting all the interior trim back into place.
