- · Connect battery charger.
- 1. Connect Star Diagnosis to the vehicle.
- 2. Transfer the settings of the EIS control module to Star Diagnosis by navigating through the following screen menus: Main Groups/Control Units/Body/EZS Electronic ignition switch/Initial Startup (follow on-screen instructions).
- 3. Replace EIS, refer to WIS: AR46.10-P-0810CW.
- 4. Continue with Initial Startup (follow on-screen instructions).
