


- with CODE (212a) Electronic traction support (ETS)

Removal

NOTE:

- ^ Refer to Notes On Brake Fluid.
- ^ Refer to Notes on Test and Repair Work to brake system.
- 1. Ignition OFF.
- 2. Disconnect hydraulic lines.
 - Seal hydraulic lines and connections with blind plugs.

CAUTION: Do not transpose lines.

3. Remove hydraulic unit.
Model 170, pull upward out of the rubber plugs.

Installation

Reverse procedure to install, noting the following:

- Install plastic caps with lugs downward.
- Tighten lines to hydraulic unit to: 15 Nm
- Bleed brake system. See: Brake Bleeding/Service and Repair
- Read and clear any Diagnostic Trouble Codes (DTC)s.
