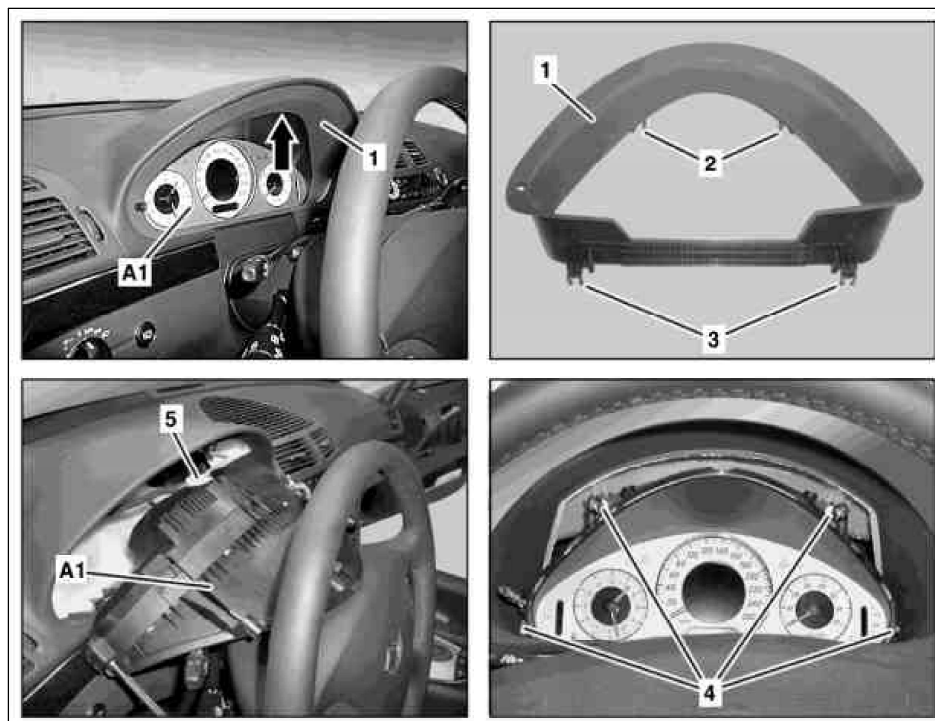

 5 Electrical connector

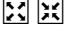


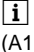
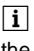



A1 Instrument cluster

1.1  AD	Connect STAR DIAGNOSIS and buffer the default data from the instrument cluster (A1) in STAR DIAGNOSIS Connect STAR DIAGNOSIS and read out fault memory	 Only when replacing the instrument cluster (A1). 1	Move steering wheel as far back and low down as possible	 See Operating Instructions	
2	Disconnect battery ground cable	Model 211.0/6 Model 211.2	AR54.10-P-0003T AR54.10-P-0003TA
3	Using the fingers, grasp into the gap (arrow) between the covering (1) and instrument cluster (A1) and pull covering (1) gently backwards until it disengages at the top latching hooks (2)	 Carefully unclip cover (1), otherwise the upper catch hook (2) can break	
4	Unclip covering (1) from lower catch hooks (3) by hand and pull out of instrument panel towards the rear	 Carefully unclip cover (1), otherwise the bottom catch hook (3) can break	
5	Remove bolts (4)		
6	Pull instrument cluster (A1) out of the instrument panel until the electrical connector (5) is accessible		
7	Unplug electrical connector (5) and remove instrument cluster (A1)		
8	Install in the reverse order
