




Clamping rear spring

 $\fbox{\cite{1}}$ When inserting the rear spring (6) make sure that the lower insert (7) and upper insert (8) are correctly seated.

- $\fbox{ }$ Clamping plate (06) and $\fbox{ }$ Insert clamping plate (07) into rear spring.
 - i S Insert clamping plates (06, 07) so that as many spring coils as possible can be pre-compressed.
