


**STEP 6** 


The new USB cable should be inserted under the ashtray door into the Ashtray itself. Then secure both cables under the ashtray and under the gearshift console (see one of the cables in the picture).



## **STEP 7**

Now reassemble the Ashtray and Gearshift console. And plug in the USB (this completes the power feed).

PS if the cig. Lighter is ignition controlled I might hardwire this connection in the future.



## **PLAY TIME**

So, when I want to play my iPod I plug the USB into the cig. Lighter and select my tunes on the iPod and rest it in the cup holder while I'm driving. The sound is excellent because I'm going through the iPod connector and NOT through the iPod's 3.5mm connector (as this reduces the audio quality and volume considerably).



When not in use the new cable and my iPod fit out of sight in the Center Console under the cup holder.



All put away for another day!..... care for a mint anyone?



## SUMMARY

Pros:

So, easy access to the iPod controls (i.e. when I'm stopped), excellent sound quality, stores safely away out of sight (I don't have to root around in my Glove Box anymore). And all this for UNDER \$12 what's not to like ③.

Cons:

Does NOT display in the dash or in the Comand screens  $\boldsymbol{\boldsymbol{\varpi}}$
