Buttons and controller

Overview

The vehicle may be equipped with the button for seat settings instead of the display on/off button.

For AMG vehicles: the controller is equipped with buttons ① and ④.

Controller

The controller in the center console lets you:

- select menu items on the display
- enter characters
- select a destination on the map
- save entries

The controller can be:

- turned (())
- slid left or right ←⊙→
- slid forwards or back ↑○↓
- slid diagonally 500
- pressed briefly or pressed and held 🔊

Back button

► To exit the menu: briefly press the button.

COMAND changes to the next higher menu level in the current operating mode.

► To call up the basic display: press the button for longer than two seconds. COMAND changes to the basic display of the current operating mode.

Clear button

► To delete individual characters: briefly press the CLEAR button on the control panel.

- ► Briefly press the c clear button on the controller.
- ► To delete individual characters: briefly press the CLEAR button on the control panel.
- ► To delete an entire entry: press and hold the CLEAR button on the control panel.

- ► Press and hold the c clear button on the controller.

Favorites button

You can assign predefined functions using the ★ favorites button and call them up by pressing the button (> page 49).

Touchpad

Touchpad overview
