Central locking:

If the door is locked using the emergency key, then in each case only this door is locked, not the complete central locking system.

**i** Procedure for locking complete vehicle:

1 Switch off ignition.

For vehicles with code 551 (Anti-theft alarm system (ATA)): When the emergency key is used, function impairments may occur in the anti-theft alarm system (ATA). To ensure that the vehicle is in a ready-to-drive condition an emergency key with limited functionality is currently available.

- 2 Remove transmitter key.
- 3 Open driver door (all other doors must be closed).
- 4 Remove emergency key from vehicle.
- 5 Operate inside switch for central locking (all doors and liftgate are locked, tank cap remains unlocked).
- 6 Lock driver door using emergency key.

To this end, the **function descriptions** in the WIS: FG 80 for the antitheft alarm system (ATA), and the information on the emergency key's **mode of operation** in the operator's manual must be observed. Corresponding information on the available key will be available in the EPC as from Release 01/2017 onwards.
