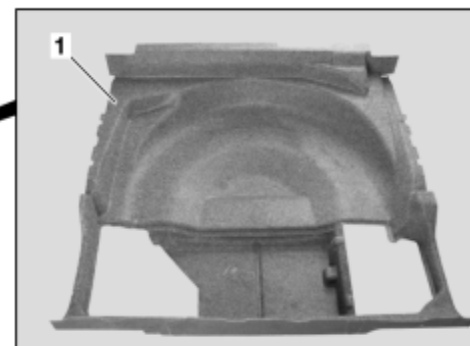
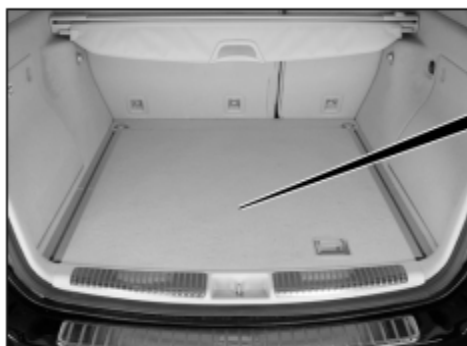

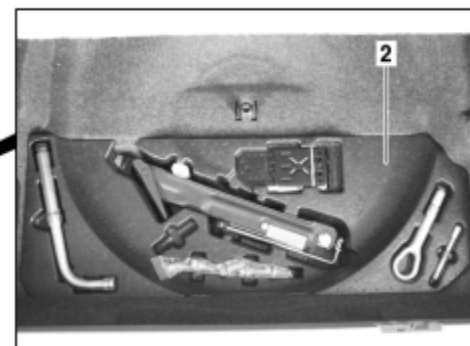
1 Spare wheel well paneling

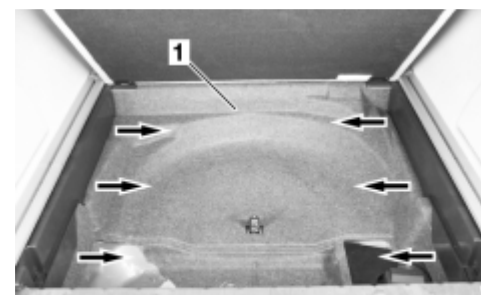



5	Remove vehicle tool kit shaped part (2) upward	 <b>Installation:</b> Observe installation position.

7.1	Remove clips from outer edges on spare wheel recess paneling (1).	 If present.	
8	Pull outer edges of spare wheel recess paneling (1) toward inside (arrows)	 Do not kink spare wheel recess paneling (1), danger of breakage!	
		 <b>Installation:</b> Ensure that outer edges of spare wheel recess paneling (1) are seated correctly.	
9	Install in the reverse order
