2	Switch off ignition and remove transmitter key from EIS control unit	ⓘ On vehicles with code (889) Keyless-Go: Press Keyless-Go start/stop button repeatedly until ignition is switched off. Remove transmitter key from vehicle and store it in a location beyond its transmission range (at least 2 m).	
3	use plastic pry tool at bottom edges Disengage dashboard center part (2) at bottom edge (arrows A) and pull forward out of dashboard	ⓘ Protect trim parts of the instrument panel and center console from scratches.
