


5	Remove trim (7) from steering column switch module (2)	<b>i</b> Installation: Pay attention to correct seating of coverings (5, 6).

7	Remove clock spring contact (A45)	i Installation: If the clock spring contact (A45) was twisted, bring the clock spring contact (A45) into the center position before reinstalling:  ↓  Turn clock spring contact (A45) clockwise up to the limit stop (turn gently against the limit stop, risk of damage), then turn counterclockwise until the arrows are opposite one another and the cable loop with black spots is visible in the window.  i Installation: Check plug contact is correctly seated on steering angle sensor (see arrow in picture 2).
