REPLACE ABC HIGH-PRESSURE LINE; INSPECT COOLANT HOSE AND

**REPLACE IF NECESSARY** 

This Service Campaign has been initiated because DCAG has determined that on affected vehicles (see VIN range below) the geometry of the ABC high pressure line may not meet specifications. This can cause the ABC high pressure line to be in contact with the engine coolant hose. The dealer will replace the ABC high pressure line with a modified version. The dealer will also check and replace the engine coolant hose if necessary.

Please review the Effective Serial Number chart located below, and if necessary, repair the subject vehicles during the vehicle's next service.

Prior to performing this Service Campaign:

- Please check VMI to insure the vehicle is involved and to determine if the vehicle has been previously repaired.
- Please review the entire Service Campaign bulletin.

Approximately 33 vehicles are affected.

#### **Procedure**

# A. INSPECT COOLANT HOSE FOR DAMAGE

- 1. Inspect coolant hose (A, Figure 1) from above for damage in circled area.
- If coolant hose is <u>not</u> damaged: Perform <u>Subject B only</u>.
- If coolant hose <u>is</u> damaged: Perform <u>Subjects B and C</u>.

## **B. REPLACE ABC HIGH-PRESSURE LINE**

- Remove fan shroud; refer to WIS document AR20.40-P-6800SZ.
- 2. Raise vehicle on lift; refer to WIS document AR00.60-P-1000SX.
- 3. Remove front and middle lower engine compartment paneling.

# **MARNING!**

Risk of injury to skin or eyes caused by hydraulic fluid spraying out under high pressure. Risk of poisoning caused by swallowing hydraulic fluid. <u>The engine must be shut off for at least 10 minutes before attempting detachment of the ABC high-pressure line</u>.



- 4. Detach ABC high-pressure line (A, Figure 2) from front axle valve unit (B).
- Plug opening of valve unit with a stop plug.



- 5. Detach steering line (A, Figure 3) from ABC high-pressure line bracket (B).
- Remove bolt (left arrow).
- 6. Detach ABC high-pressure line bracket (B, Figure 3) from refrigerant compressor (C).
- Remove bolt (right arrow).
- 7. Lower vehicle.
- 8. Detach ABC high-pressure line (A, Figure 4) from upper bracket (B).



- 9. Detach ABC high-pressure line (A, Figure 5) from tandem pump and remove from vehicle.
- Remove TORX 40 bolts (arrows).
- 10. Install new ABC high-pressure line in reverse order.
- Torque ABC high-pressure line at tandem pump to 9 Nm.
- Torque ABC high-pressure line at upper bracket to 8 Nm.
- Torque ABC high-pressure line bracket at refrigerant compressor to 20 Nm.
- Torque steering line at ABC high-pressure line bracket to 10 Nm.
- Torque ABC high-pressure line at front axle valve unit to 20 Nm.
- 11. Fill and bleed Active Body Control (ABC); refer to WIS document AR32.50-P-0021SX.

# **CAUTION!**

Ensure the funnel and filter used in this procedure have not been used for pouring other operating fluids in order to prevent contaminants from entering and damaging the ABC system.

#### C. REPLACE COOLANT HOSE

1. Drain coolant; refer to WIS document AR20.00-P-1142H.

## Note:

Only drain coolant from the radiator, not the whole system.

2. Replace coolant hose.
