Reason for change	

Complaint:

The function of the steering wheel switch panels can only be used to a limited extent or they are completely nonfunctional. The customer receives a corresponding notification in the instrument cluster.

Cause:

High air humidity may make the conductor tracks in the steering wheel switch panels conductive.

Remedy:

Replace steering wheel switch panels and steering wheel electronics (see EPC design group 46 STEERING, subgroup 105 STEERING WHEEL AND STEERING WHEEL LOCK picture chart CODE 808 -> Positions 120 and 140):

- 1. Remove airbag unit (see A, attachment 1) from steering wheel (comparison: AR91.60-P-0660LF).
- Important: Disconnect ground cable from on-board electrical system battery!
- 2. Remove bolts (see B, attachment 2) and remove retaining plate (see C, attachment 2).
- 3. Remove bolts (see D, attachment 3) and unclip cover (see E, attachment 3) with switch panels on steering wheel.
- Important: Disconnect electrical connection of switch panels from steering wheel.
- 4. Remove bolts (see F, attachment 4) from left and right switch panel then remove switch panels from cover and replace them (see E, attachment 3).
- 5. Disconnect remaining connectors from contact plate (see G, attachment 5) and remove from steering wheel.
- Important: Contact plate lies loosely in steering wheel after removal of cover.
- 6. Assemble in reverse order
