Count: 1
The accused is sentenced to imprisonment for a **period of 12 months**. Order that the whole term of imprisonment be suspended forthwith; and the accused must not commit another offence punishable by imprisonment within a **period of 3 years** if to avoid being dealt with for the suspended term of imprisonment.
